**Bed Bath & Beyond Inc. and its subsidiaries (collectively, the “Company”) are committed to providing customers with safe, high quality products.** To that end, the Company has set policies in regard to the use of flame retardants in products.

Flame retardant chemicals may be added to a large variety of consumer products, including, but not limited to, furniture, electronics, and baby products. Some U.S. states have enacted restrictions regarding the use of these chemicals. It is our expectation that all Vendors (“Vendors” used throughout this document means all Vendors, including Owned Brand) comply with all federal, state, and local laws and regulations associated with flame retardant chemicals.

Furthermore, it is our expectation that Vendors also adhere to our corporate policy for flame retardant chemicals, as set forth below:

### **COMPANY CORPORATE POLICY:**

The following flame retardants may not be used in any product sold to Company:

Polybrominated biphenyls (PBBs)	59536-65-1
Pentabromodiphenylether (PentaBDE)	32534-81-9
Octabromodiphenylether (OctaBDE)	32536-52-0
Tris-(2, 3-dibromopropyl) phosphate (TRIS)	126-72-7
Tris(2-chloroethyl) phosphate (TCEP)	115-96-8
Tris (1,3-dichloro-2-propyl) phosphate (TDCPP)	13674-87-8
Tri(chloropropyl) phosphate(TCPP)	13674-84-5
Tris-(aziridinyl) phosphin oxide (TEPA)	545-55-1
Decabromodiphenyl ether (DecaBDE)	1163-19-5
Tetrabromobisphenol A (TBBPA)	79-94-7
Hexabromocyclododecane (HBCDD)	25637-99-4

In addition, the following products must not contain ANY chemical flame retardants:

- Upholstered Furniture
- Mattresses and Pads used in juvenile products such as cribs, bassinets, cradles, play yards, etc.
- Gliders and Ottomans –designed for nurseries
- Changing Pads
- Children’s Sleepwear
